History of the Consulate. The first consular post of the United States to be established in western Canada was a Consulate at Victoria, in what was then the Colony of Vancouver Island; and the first consular officer was Allen Francis, of Illinois, appointed Consul at Victoria by President Lincoln on November 11, 1861.

There are typically one or more deputy consuls-general, consuls, vice-consuls and consular agents working under the consul-general. History. The American Consulate General in Marseille, France is one of the United State's oldest overseas posts.
